


For Meeting #3 of the Policy and Practice Project, the Advisory Team is starting to examine and learn from data pertaining to <u>Calls for Service</u> in the Police Department.



WHY look at data?

Because we measure what matters.

Data tells us where the problems and gaps are so we can focus time, money, and energy on what needs the most work.



One question Advisory Team members wanted to know first:

What is the most recent information on the demographics of Red Wing?



Population

Red Wing is slightly decreasing in population.

16,320 (-0.8% since 2010)

Age

Red Wing is an aging community.

More than one out of five people already are 65 or older.

Under Under Between 65 years 5 years 18 years 19 and 64 years and older 5.7% 22.1% 56.6% 21.3%

In comparison, Minnesota has 16.3% over age 65.



Racial and Ethnic Diversity

1 in 10 of us is a person of color.

1 in 4 in our school district is a student of color.

Housing

Lack of Housing is one of Red Wing's top concerns.

Homeownership rate: 67% Tenant/renter rate: 33%

Cost burdened: 46% of renters

25% of homeowners

Defined as those who pay more than 1/3 of their income on housing

Median sale price of a home \$191,250

Median Monthly Rent: \$825

Median Monthly Mortgage: \$1,257

Percent completed high school: 94.2%
